In soft, muted colours and with breath-taking attention to detail, they depict the bustling waterside; the boulevard of Georgian town houses; people at work on the dock; and a grand fleet of tall ships. Taking centre stage on the chimney breast is an extremely rare image of George IV.

Having been sensitively restored to their former glory by a team of experts, the murals provide a stunning and elegant backdrop for a radiant bride as she makes her grand entrance through the double doors and walks down the aisle to join her groom.

You'll be surrounded by almost 200 years of history as you exchange vows in the presence of your family and friends. Our Mural Rooms offer an unrivalled setting for a truly stylish, memorable and unique wedding day.

Your Wedding Planner

As soon as possible

- ★ Decide what date you would like to get married
- ★ Find out who is going to pay for each part of your wedding and set a budget
- ★ Decide who you would like to invite. This will enable you to find a suitable venue and work out how much the wedding will cost
- ★ Book hotel and provisionally book ceremony (in England and Wales you have to be married within 12 months of giving notice to marry)
- ★ Talk about guest accommodation, will any guests need to stop over
- ★ Consider buying wedding insurance
- ★ Decide what type of music to have at your reception entertainment (the hotel may have some different suggestions to offer. it's worth talking to them)
- ★ Ask your friends and family to find a suitable photographer & book
- ★ Decide on type of cake and order
- ★ Find & book suitable wedding cars
- ★ Start the search for the perfect wedding dress

6 Months before

- ★ Choose the bridesmaids dresses, shoes & accessories
- ★ Decide on and find outfits for groom, best man, ushers... etc
- ★ Talk to mothers about their outfits
- ★ Book your florist
- ★ Finalise menus & drinks with The Lowther Hotel

4 Months to go

- ★ Decide on your wedding rings
- ★ Write a gift list
- ★ Finalise design & colours of wedding cake
- ★ Are you going abroad for your honeymoon? Check passports & look into changing your surname if you wish to travel in your married name

3 Month to go

- ★ Send out invitations
- ★ Any more wedding stationary to be ordered e.g. place cards etc
- ★ Decide on hair styles and talk to hair dresser. Have a trial run
- Find a make-up artist and have a trial run
- ★ Have your Best man & Chef bridesmaid arrange your stag & hen parties

2 Months to go

- ★ Book Hair appointment
- ★ Arrange the make-up artist
- ★ Talk to the Lowther and give them final numbers
- ★ Final fitting for wedding dress and check clothing is still ok for the rest of the wedding party

1 Month to go

- ★ Confirm transport details
- ★ Draw up table plans with the Lowther Hotel
- ★ Visit florist and confirm details

1-2 Weeks before

- ★ Talk to the Lowther to finalise order of events and have a rehearsal if needed

On the big day

- ★ Get up with plenty of time to spare
- ★ Have a lazy bath
- ★ Eat breakfast, it could be a long time to your next meal
- ★ Get ready, leaving plenty of time
- ★ Enjoy yourself on the most important day of your life.
