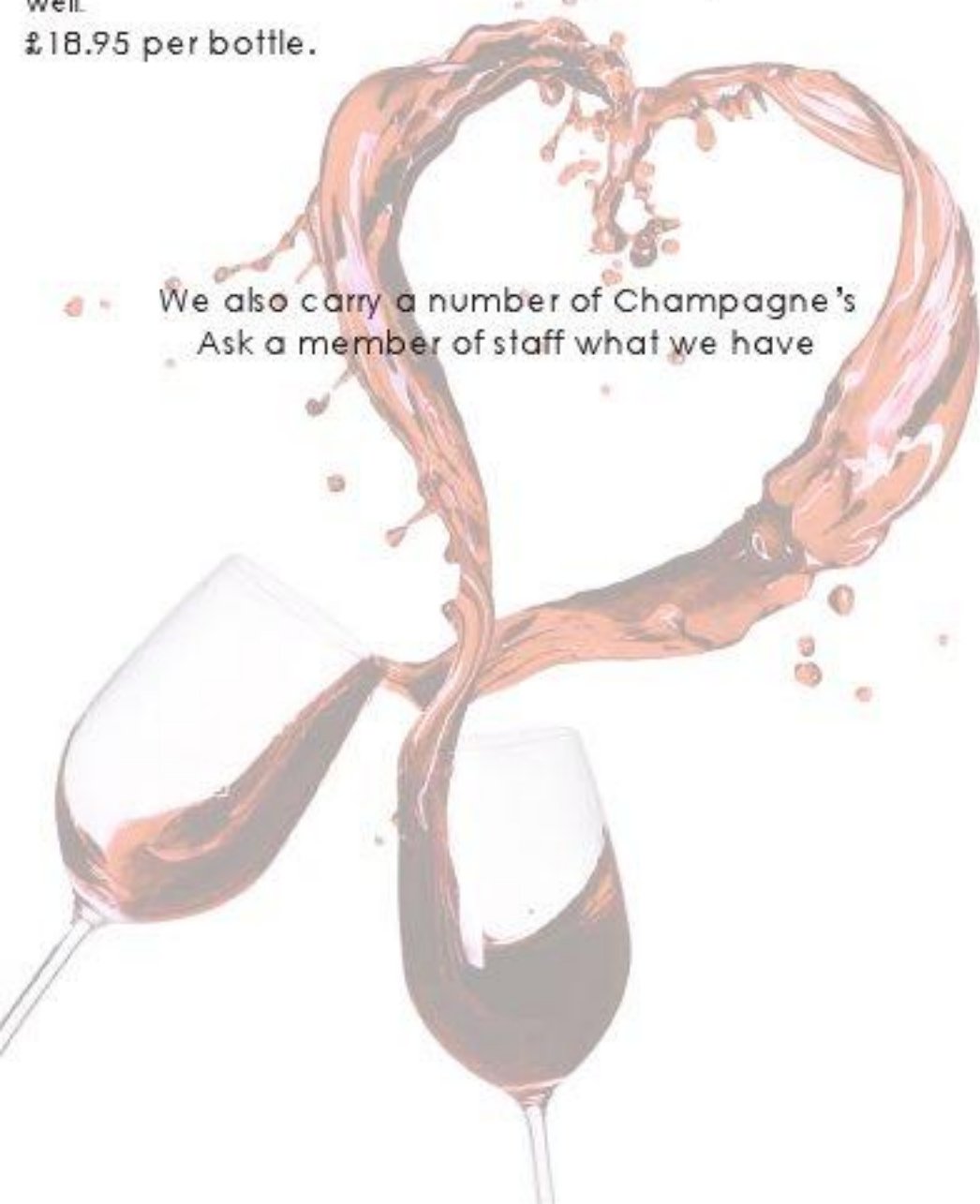
Vineyards V8 Prosecco. 11.5% ABV

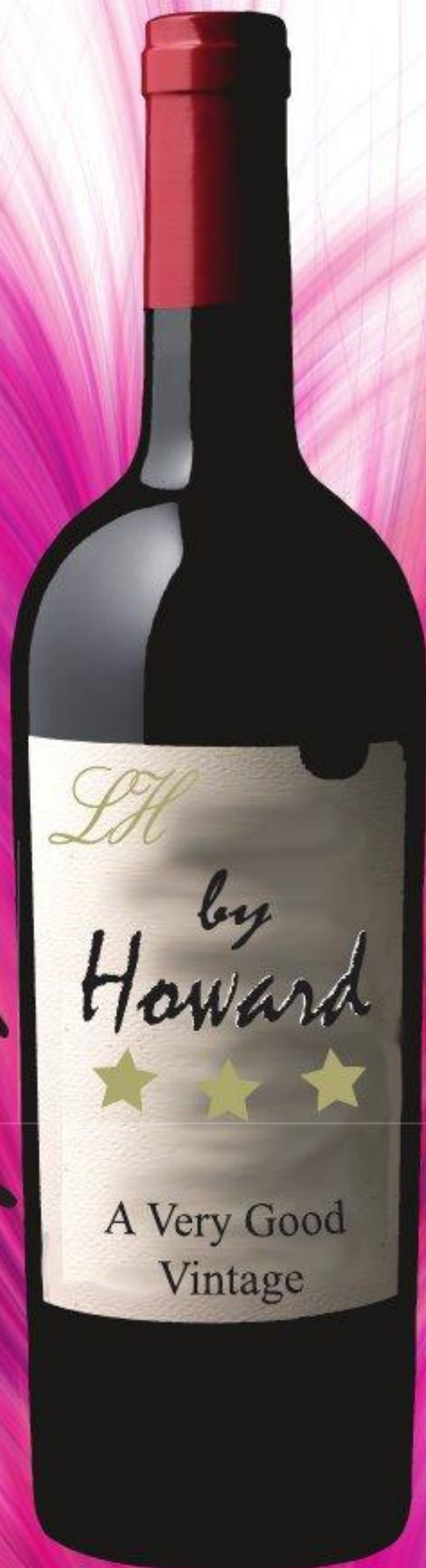
Rose V8 Prosecco. 11.5% ABV

Marechal Dry Sauvignon Blanc, vin De France. 11.5% ABV

This is our entry level wine. This is a light, dry, medium bodied, stylish wine with a lively fruit background and refreshing acidity. It is very affordable. Perhaps a second one?

125ml - £2.75, 175ml - £3.50, 250ml - £4.50 or Bottle - £11.95

Marechal Medium Chenin Blanc, Vin De France. 11.0% ABV

This is a clean, fresh and well balanced, medium white wine with a refreshing fruit character showing through to its long last finish. A really nice French medium white.

La Pintora. Sauvignon Blanc 12.5%ABV

This sauvignon Blanc is from Chile's central valley, it's a medium dry white wine. The area has a superb Mediterranean style climate with a perfect balance of sunshine irrigation and soil. Its fruity bouquet and characteristic flavor are of a quality sauvignon Blanc. It's un-oaked fruity flavours come through on your palette.

Lavilla Wanni, Pinot Grigio. 12.0% ABV

The colour of this superb Italian wine is an intense straw yellow in its appearance with a ripe fruity bouquet. The pallet is medium in body with a good crisp acidity and plenty of soft, ripe fruit flavors. A really nice Pinot Grigio.

Niersteinev Gutes Domtal QBA Schmitt Sohne.

I used to drink a lot of German wine in the 70's, this taste is the same, really nice but without the 'anti-freeze'. Ok, it was the Austrians who had the 'anti-freeze' but they both got the blame. Seriously, this is a full flavored wine from the vineyards of the Rhine valley. This is a lovely medium-sweet wine, with a fragrant nose, good body and refreshing steely fruit.

'Pitchfork' Chardonnay, McLaren Vale. Australia 12.5% ABV

A beautiful example of an Australian unoaked chardonnay. Its got a pale lemon green colour with aromas of honeysuckle and citrus blossom. Its palate is full and luscious displaying tropical pineapple and lime with a clean crisp lingering finish

Mirror Lake Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand.

I have got to declare this was bought with three people in mind yourself, Julie and I. The Marlborough reign receives lots of sunshine and Lake Matheson in New Zealand has evolved over time to combine a selection of nature's best ingredients. It's clear, mirror like waters perfectly reflect the imposing icy peaks of Mount Tasman. It goes without saying this fresh, crisp Marlborough New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc combines some of nature's best gooseberry and passion fruit notes to create this perfect wine for every occasion. So Enjoy! We do and I hope you will.

13.5% ABV - £18.95 per bottle.

Torrentes Viognier, Crios de Sasana Balbo, Cafayate, Argentina

When Julie and I want to celebrate, or just spoil ourselves (sometimes you just have to!) we choose this Torrentes with its crisp taste. It has a brilliant gold colour and is a perfect example of the viognier grape with its peach, apricot and almond flavours. I hope you enjoy it as much as we do.

13.5% ABV - £21.95 per bottle

Domanine Phillippe Testut Chablis, Burgandy France

This beautiful classic French full flavoured Chablis is elegant and classy with a superb lingering finish on the palate. A fine example, a Chablis to really savor.

12.5% ABV - £24.95

La Pintora Merlot. 12.5% ABV

Starts our red offering but don't think worse of it with a rich deep appearance. This intense ruby red wine is un-oaked, medium bodied and has the aroma of ripe berries with a hint of chocolate. The flavour demonstrates generous fruit and soft tannins. Fantastic value for money!

Hidden Rock. Australian Petit Verdot and Cabernet Sauvignon.

This should be a more expensive wine, it's a full flavoured blend of 80% petit verdot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. As you know petit verdot is a rare grape variety and is normally found in classic Bordeaux wines adding colour and richness. It's rich and youthful dark berry characteristics lead with subtle vanilla oak to a softly textured palate with an exceptional depth of flavour. A real bargain!

14.0% ABV £12.95 per bottle.

Sangiovese di Puglia, Vetricano, Italy 13.5% ABV

I believe that you can taste the sunshine in certain wines. When we tasted this one the sunshine just leapt out. It comes from Southern Italy so I guess it's not surprising that the sunshine comes through. It is a soft, spicy red wine with red berry fruit flavours. Enjoy the wine ... and the sunshine!

Vega del Rayo Rioja Spain 12.5% ABV

I love this Rioja with concentrated black cherry characteristics and a rounded spice finish from tempranillo and mazuelo grape varieties selected from low yielding vineyards in Rioja. The palate is richly flavoured and substantial with plenty of berry fruit and a smokey, spicy dimension from its six months in oak barrels. I do, so I hope you enjoy it too.

£16.95 per bottle.

Sunny Cliff, Shiraz, Australia 13.5% ABV

This 2008 Shiraz was blended from grapes harvested from the vineyards at Red Cliffs in Victoria. Its nose is rich in spicy fruit cake and raisin aromas with subtle hints of chocolate and cinnamon. Its developed in the bottle for a couple of years and by now is perfect.

£17.95 per bottle

Turi, Pinot Noir, Vina Leyda, Chile 13.5% ABV

The Chileans make great wine. The climate is perfect for vines. This wine comes from the vineyards located in the central valley with the Andes Mountains overlooking and a strong coastal influence. This fruit driven style of wine with red cherries, soft spiciness and nice acidity goes well with salmon and light pasta.

£19.95 per bottle

Malbec Lunta, Mendel, Argentina 14.0% ABV

This is one of Julie's favorites. It is fresh and intense with cherry and plum aromas with a touch of liquorice present giving the wine a pleasant complexity. A superb wine.

£21.95 per bottle

Fleurie Domanie de Gry-Sablon, Beaujolais, France

Wine has been made at the Domanie de Gry-Sablon for over a century. The gamay grape thrives in the granite soils found in the village of Fleurie at the heart of the Beaujolais region. With delicate cherry scents and flavours of red berry fruits this very elegant red wine is an excellent partner for a wide variety of dishes
